Process for Submitting a Non-Profit Company Nominee/Proposal for a Donation

Moves that Matter is an endeavor that seeks to benefit charities and charitable entities arising from the experiences of TQL's employees, customers, and carriers. Every day, we work together to move freight throughout North America. While some loads contain ordinary shipments, others contain something extraordinary. They contain hope, and healing, and they rouse us to take immense pride in our daily job. **Read the story here of TQL's first Moves that Matter.**

If you have played a part in helping a recognized 501(c)(3) organization transport an important load of freight, tell us about it and we may make a \$1,000 donation to the non-profit.

Requests for funding are reviewed by TQL's Charitable Giving Committee, which meets on a monthly basis. A minimum of one (1) donation request per month will be granted. **Only requests that have an accompanying TQL Load number will be considered. Donations will only be made to organizations that have properly obtained and maintain a 501(c)(3) status as recognized by the Internal Revenue Service of the United States of America. Proof of this status may be required before any donation is made.**

To be considered for Moves that Matter, requests must be submitted in writing and contain the following information:

- **Your full name, title, telephone number, email address and/or fax number. All submissions must be made by an individual.**
- **Name of your company or your employer who was directly involved with the hauling of the shipment including, address, telephone number, email address and/or fax number**
- **Your role as it relates to this shipment (i.e. shipper, carrier, receiver, etc.)**
- **TQL Load number**
- **Full name of the 501(c)(3) to be considered to receive a \$1,000 donation, along with an address, telephone number, email address and/or fax number of a contact at the organization.**
- **General information including a brief history of the organization, its goals and achievements, description of clients/groups served, and the geographical area it serves**
- **If possible, the 501(c)(3)'s registration number with the IRS and the locations of its headquarters. If known, the purpose of the 501(c)(3) nominee.**
- **What was the non-profit's role as it related to this shipment?**
- **Why was this particular load so important?**

By submitting a request for Moves that Matter, the nominator is conveying his or her express written consent as follows:

1. Nominator, under penalty of fraud, represents that he/she is at least eighteen (18) years of age and is able to be contractually bound and is submitting this nomination in good faith.

2. Nominator consents and agrees to allow TQL to utilize the information he or she has provided for any purpose outlined herein, and irrevocably grant TQL the irrevocable right to use his/her image(s) in photographs, motion pictures, recordings, or other records for use in advertising, promotion, or marketing and assigns all rights, title, and interest in any such photographs, motion pictures, recordings, or other records taken, captured, or created by TQL to TQL without compensation.
3. Nominator agrees to defend, indemnify and hold TQL harmless from and against any and all claims arising from or relating in any way to Nominator's involvement and/or participation in the nominating process; provided, however, that Nominator shall not be liable for any negligence or willful misconduct on the part of TQL.
4. Nominator agrees that all issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of the Nomination process and Nominator's rights and obligations in connection with the process, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Ohio, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules, and Participant consents to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the federal, state and local courts in Clermont County, Ohio.
